#### **FEEDING FUTURES**

At our assembly yesterday I spoke to the students about the importance of this program and the individual responsibility that comes with it. It really touches on all **our HAWKS values:** 

Helpful: The food is available to those who need it.

Accountable: It is a system that is not to be abused, but rather used when needed.

Wise: Students are encouraged to think before they access the food. Do they really need it?

Kind: This a way to ensure all students who need the food are not stigmatized for it.

Safe: Students should be aware of any food allergies they may have or ask an adult.

This food is NOT to replace the healthy snacks and lunches that families are able to send. It is meant to satisfy a need for students whose families can't afford to provide healthy food for their children at this time, or for students in the event of an emergency, who require a healthy snack.
