Dear Hamilton Families,

Tomorrow the **FSA testing booklets and results page** will be sent home with students in grades 4 and 7. We encourage you to look at the results with your child and discuss the questions in the booklet. The booklet questions have all been marked by Richmond Teachers and provide a snapshot of how your child is progressing in Literacy and Numeracy.

With the **icy conditions** that have been left from the winter storm we experienced on Tuesday, we are encouraging everyone in the community to be extra safe when walking or driving around the school. While we have seen an improvement lately with people dropping off and picking up their children, **parents stopping on the east side (adjacent to the school) of Smith drive is still a problem**. Even stopping for a very short period of time prevents children and parents from being seen when crossing the street and can force other drivers to pull around the stopped vehicle. This stretch of Smith Drive is clearly marked as a NO STOPPING zone.

Today we had a presentation in our gym by **DreamRider Productions**. The name of the show, **Zero Heroes**, is a fun and educational way to help children learn about environmental literacy and better understand the problem we have in the world of producing too much garbage, and ways *we all* can do our part to reduce the waste that goes into our landfills. One of the things they talked about is a litter less lunch, where lunches are packed using reusable containers, utensils, and napkins. We have been providing plastic spoons and forks for students if they require them but **beginning in January, we will no longer be providing these**.
