In November, you would have received an email from <u>"sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca"</u> with your login ID and temporary password. Instructions on how to login and navigate the Parent Portal can be found on our school website.

Access the Parent Portal at: https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do

- The first login must be done from a worksation, laptop or computer. <u>Do not use an iPad,</u> <u>tablet or cell phone</u>. After the initial log in you may use any device to access your parent portal account.
- Enter the login ID and password provided in the MyED BC email
- The first time you log on to your account you will be asked to change your password
