Dear Hamilton Families,

What a beautiful morning as our intermediate students and staff are heading off to Minoru for our annual **Zone Track Meet**. We wish them all well as they compete against other Richmond schools in events like long distance running, high jump, long jump, shot put, relays, and others. A great deal of work goes into organizing the event and this year Ms. Burroughs-Chan and Ms. Pattyson again took on that role and did a fantastic job getting us ready for the day. And a big shout out to Mr. Janz who gave up so many of his lunch hours to work with students competing in the high jump. Our week closes out tomorrow after school with a Popcorn & Ring Pop sale sponsored by our PAC. Next week on Tuesday evening many of our **Band students will be performing at Gateway Theatre** and on Wednesday evening, **Saleema Noon Group** will be putting on a virtual **Body Science presentation for Parents** generously sponsored by our PAC.

On a more serious note, on Monday morning I became aware of a homeless man who has been in the neighborhood recently. When I arrived on Monday at the school, he was at the charity bins in front of the community centre looking for clothing. As a precaution, and since he was so close to the school, I contacted the RCMP who said they would monitor the situation, but at that time, had no reason to confront him. That morning I informed all my staff and made an announcement to the students informing them that he is likely just a person who is down on his luck, but that they should be aware of him and if he was to be seen on the school grounds, to contact an adult and the office immediately. Since that time, I have been informed that the RCMP were going to be contacting the man to do a mental health assessment. Since Monday I have not seem him, nor has it been reported to me that he has been anywhere around the school. While my priority is always to keep our students and staff safe, I believe we also want to instill empathy and compassion in our students for people who are going through difficult times or are dealing with challenging health issues.
