Motion to approve previous meeting minutes from May 15, 2024 – Juliana and Melissa

#### **SCHOOL REPORT:** [Mark McCallum & Karen Burroughs-Chan]

- Update on School Activities & Happenings
  - A big thank you to PAC!
  - Retirement function tomorrow night for Mr. Pawer & Ms. Baatz (Staff only)
  - Year end field trips to Centennial Beach or Watermania, Grade 6/7's Bike & Hike around Queensborough
  - June 21<sup>st</sup>: Gr 7 farewell with assembly in morning, luncheon and then year end celebration at Centennial beach
  - Received Track ribbons- will see which day we will hand out ribbons (at Farewell Assembly on 26<sup>th</sup> or at Slide show on 27<sup>th</sup>)
  - Learning updates come out last day of school online; staff are busy with final assessment
  - Hired 2 teachers Miran Lo (experienced resource teacher) and Abigail Aguilar (from Diefenbaker) as possible K/1 teacher in Ms. Baatz room
  - Two postings still in process for 75% relief teacher (Ms. Malayeri will be off on maternity for 1.5 years); she currently takes the classes for teachers when they are having their prep periods; close to hiring someone
  - EA posting out now; close to hiring; will know by next week; currently have 13 EAs; will have 14 for next year
  - Only 40 Ks coming in September
  - anticipate will go back to 17 divisions for Sept

#### TREASURER'S REPORT: [Juliana Yim]

- Update on Gaming and Operating Accounts
  - Fun lunch; \$11,000; gaming grant: \$7640, Walkathon: \$7056, Neufeld: \$1980, Afterschool snacks (ring pop, popcorn, donuts): \$1483, Sports Day concession: \$572, Silent Auction: \$445, Passive: \$727, total raised: \$30,904
  - **Expenses** classroom resources: \$5831, K-Pop dance program: \$4800, transportation Track & Field: \$2000, School Spirit (pumpkin patch, WAT cookies): \$1239, McNair Scholarship: \$500, MunchaLunch Processing Fee: \$336, Dare Program: \$250, Earthquake Supplies: \$67, Welcome Back (Coffee/Snacks): \$63, Staff Appreciation: \$42; Total expenses: **\$15,128**; \$15,000 going to next year for future use

#### **Operating:** we have \$35,727 balance in bank

- Budget for retirement teachers: Motion to increase our budget for retirement teachers from \$200 to \$300 because we have TWO teachers retiring this year. Motion approved.

Gaming: restricted account; we need a full PAC Exec team to get the Gaming Grant (\$20 per student)

- \$14,721 total revenue minus expenses = \$12,704 still in bank for next year to use

#### • Fun Lunch Fridays update

- Pizza lunch (last) 2<sup>nd</sup> time using Boston Pizza; 4 parent volunteers delivered 248 pizzas to all classes in less than 30 mins with no student support! Will continue using BP for pizzas in future
- Subway lunch on sports day highest order: 217 subs
- 2 more lunches to go this month Chinese and then pasta
- Gr 5 students expressing interest in volunteering!
- Fun lunch Friday has made \$11,000 30% profit margin
- MunchaLunch (MAL) Admin fee must be paid by July 31 \$300+\$36 GST/PST. MAL is not a food vendor; It's the software program used for online billing; motion to continue using MunchaLunch. Motion approved.
- Any suggestions on new vendors, please bring forward; BALA Foods was suggested by a parent!
- When we switched to bundle ordering, it helped to reduce reminders and transaction fees
- Thank you for making Fun Lunch weekly!

#### • Update: Walkathon, Sports Day, Silent Auction

- WAT raised \$7,056!
- Sports Day Save on Foods and Starbucks came through with recess snacks and coffee; made almost \$1000 from subway lunch and concession sales; all popcorn/ring pops were sold; all Fresh Slice cups given away; lots of parent volunteers Thank you, volunteers!
- Silent Auction a creative opportunity to develop; thanks to generosity of community partners to donate; next year we will set earlier deadline and can ask for gift donations from parents/families

#### **COMMUNICATIONS:** [Jessica Hubele]

- Facebook Cleanup
  - PAC has done a lot of work with the administrative sides of things like the guidelines and policy
  - May 28 241 members, informed about clean-up, now down to 170 members; down 30%. We've added 8 new members; Thanks to Ms. Hinz and Lorita for assistance; completely in accordance with our guidelines; we did a FB cleanup as we only wanted appropriate people to be notified of school business; had to set boundaries about the purpose of the PAC page; it took some work to put together; we needed to confirm the right people are in the group and digital safety is a concern

#### **NEW BUSINESS:** [Lorita Tang-Withers]

- Voting for September PAC Executive Team for next school year
  - Why? Voting to fill executive and coordinator positions in PAC; if we don't have a Chair, Secretary and Treasurer at minimum then we do not receive the government funding (\$7000) and will lose all that we have in the bank
  - This coming school year will be Lorita's last year; she can help new person transition into her Chair position
  - Juliana has only 3 years left and overlap is needed!
  - We also have Sept to vote in; please think about yourself or others who may be interested in these positions!
