Construction Around the School

I have been assured the drainage work on Smith Drive and the fire hydrant installation on Gilley will be completed today and both roads will be open for the start of school on Tuesday. That said, we would like to caution all students and parents arriving and leaving the school that construction work across Smith Drive from the school will continue. While we have asked the construction company to limit traffic during drop-off and pick-up times, there still may be trucks on the road at any given time, and we want everyone to be safe as they travel to and from the school. Please note that space in our parking lot will be limited so we ask that you allow space for the people working at the community centre and school. Thank you!

Cell Phone/Digital Device Use in Schools

You can help your child stay focused and engaged in their education by helping to reduce digital device distractions. Support them in managing their cell phone and digital device use to make their learning experiences better. Please have a conversation with your child(ren) regarding the rules for use of digital devices at school.

- 1. It is recommended that students do not bring personal devices to school. If students bring personal devices (any personal electronic device that can be used to communicate or to access the internet, such as a cell phone, smartwatch or a tablet) to school for educational purposes, need to be used only under direct supervision by a teacher (i.e., not in the hallway, not out of sight) and only for the purpose of a specific learning activity.
- 2. These devices are to be kept in a secure place at the discretion of the teacher. The devices are not to be taken outside of the classroom at any time (for breaks, to go to the washroom, when going to another class/band, etc.)
- 3. If students have an "emergency" use for a phone at any time during the day they are welcome to come to the office to have us make this call with them or use the classroom phone under **direct supervision by a teacher**. Students should not be receiving or making calls/texts while at school on any device (personal or school).
- 4. If a device is not required for a learning activity, it should not be brought to school.

- 5. If parents want to send their child to school with a phone for before and after school safety, that is the only time they need to have access to it.
- 6. Any student who is not complying with these safety rules will risk having their device held by the office until the end of the day. Further non-compliance will result in a phone call home to parents reminding them of our school policy.
