How Parents Can Help...

This morning while I was supervising at the front of the school, I witnessed an unusually large number of cars dropping off students after our 8:45 start time. This is **the most congested I have seen our drop off zone in the six years** I have been at Hamilton. I understand that some of the congestion was due to the construction across from the school on Gilley and Smith, but I need to impart on all of you **how important it is to arrive earlier than 8:40, be patient when coming into the drop-off zone, and most importantly, do NOT pull in on an angle or leave your car**

unattended. It is so important that we have a constant flow to the drop-off. Pulling in on an angle to the curb means you will then have to then back up to leave which causes extra confusion and safety concerns. Especially in lieu of the tragic accident at Horseshoe Bay yesterday which claimed the life of a 4-year-old boy, we always need to be diligent in ensuring the areas around the school are safe. Thank you for your continued attention to this matter.
