12:40pm - students will gather back in classrooms for attendance

**12:45pm** - students will be directed to head out to the field to meet their family teams and sit with teams for tug-of-wars

**12:50pm** – Tug of wars (Primary & Intermediate)

**1:25pm** – students head back to classrooms for ribbons and dismissal
