I have a question about Fun Lunch Fridays, who do I contact?

What do I do if I miss the order due date?

Unfortunately, no adjustments can be made. The MunchaLunch website works on a pre-set schedule that we follow to ensure successful Fun Lunch Fridays every week.

Do I have to order all the lunches from each bundle?

No. You're welcome to purchase any number of lunches from each bundle at your liking. Please double check bundle due dates to avoid missing out.

Help! I can't remember if I ordered lunch for my family member.

If you have purchased a lunch, MunchaLunch will send you an email reminder the day before. You can also view your order history by logging into your MunchaLunch account, clicking *View* under *My Order*.

Can I get a refund if I cancel my child's lunch?

No. Cash or credit card refunds are not available. MunchaLunch processes order payments a week prior to lunch day. The website offers account credit only when you cancel your child's lunch more than a week prior to the scheduled lunch date. The credit can only to be used for future lunch purchases within the current school year.

What do I do if I ordered a lunch, but my child is absent that day?

Please contact the Hamilton Fun Lunch team at hamiltonfunlunch@gmail.com to inform us of your child's absence. We will correspond with you regarding the next steps available:

- Pick up the lunch from the main school office between 12:00pm - 3:00pm
- Give the lunch to a sibling to eat or take home
- Donate the lunch to a volunteer.

Why do I need to pack utensils for my child's lunch?

Our restaurant vendors do not supply disposable utensil and napkins. We encourage our Hamilton families to follow the school's sustainability goals to eliminate unnecessary waste.
